


# 106 Advanced Seminar: Seattle, WA

**The Section 106 Advanced Seminar will be held on Thursday, May 23, 2013**

**Important note:** Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

**Registration:** Payment may be made by on-line credit card registration or by check or SF 182. Go to: <http://www.achp.gov/106advanced.html> to register.

**Course Location and Accommodations:** The course is being held at The Fairmont Olympic Hotel, 411 University Street, Seattle, WA 98101 ([www.fairmont.com/Seattle](http://www.fairmont.com/Seattle)). A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Wednesday, May 22 at the government rate of \$137 for a single occupancy plus applicable state and local taxes (15.6%). It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by May 1, 2013. Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. **To reserve your room**, call 206-621-1700 x 3131 or Global Reservation Center at 1-800-441-1414 and identify yourself as being with the ACHP – Section 106 Advanced.



**Traveling to Seattle:** Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA-TAC), <http://www.portseattle.org/seatac/>, is 15 miles from the hotel. Traveling time is approximately 30 minutes.

- The Sound Transit Link Right Rail goes from the airport to several downtown locations for around \$2.75 one way. The closest stop for the Fairmont Hotel is the University Street Station at 3<sup>rd</sup> and Seneca. (1.5 blocks away).
- Taxi fare to the hotel is approximately \$35 to \$40.

**Parking at Hotel:** Self parking is available at The Olympic Garage, located at the corner of 5th Avenue and Seneca Street at \$34 overnight.

**Registration:** Registration will be located outside the conference room on Thursday at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

**Schedule:** *The Advanced Seminar* runs from 8:30 a.m. to approximately 4:30 p.m. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a longer break for lunch.

**Meals:** Light morning fare and an afternoon snack are provided. The cost of this food is included in your registration fee. All other meals are on your own.

**Attire for Training Course:** Attire for the course is casual. Also, please keep in mind that hotel meeting rooms tend to be cool, so plan to bring a sweater or jacket.

**Cancellations:** Registrants who cancel at least 14 days prior to the start of the course will receive a full refund minus a 15% processing fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the start of the course; however, substitutions may be made at no cost up until three days before the course begins. All cancellations must be made in writing.
