**Preserve America Grants in 25 States to be Announced  
April 7 During Call-in Press Conference**

WASHINGTON, D.C.— Deputy Secretary of the Interior Lynn Scarlett, along with Advisory Council on Historic Preservation Chairman John L. Nau, III, will announce Preserve America Grants in 25 states on a teleconference Monday, April 7.

The Preserve America grant program began in 2006 as part of a larger White House effort to encourage and support community efforts to preserve and enjoy our nation's heritage. Scarlett and Nau co-chair the Preserve America initiative. The grant program is administered by the Department of the Interior's National Park Service in partnership with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation.
