


106 Advanced Seminar: Atlanta, GA

The Section 106 Advanced Seminar will be held on Tuesday, April 8

Important note: Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

Registration: Payment may be made by on-line credit card registration or by check or SF 182. Go to: <http://www.achp.gov/106advanced.html> to register.

Course Location and Accommodations: The course is being held in the Connally Meetings Room at Fairfield Inn and Suites, 54 Peachtree Street SW, Atlanta GA, 30303. (<http://www.marriott.com/hotels/travel/atlus-fairfield-inn-and-suites-atlanta-downtown/>). A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Monday April 7 at the government rate of \$133 for a single occupancy plus applicable state and local tax (16%). **It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by March 24, 2014.** Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. **To reserve your room**, call 678.702.8600 and request the ACHP – Section 106 Advanced group block.



Traveling to Atlanta: Atlanta is served by the Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (<http://www.atlanta-airport.com>). The airport is approximately 9.5 miles and 15 minutes from the hotel.

Hotel Information: The Inn offers free breakfast, complimentary high-speed internet access; complimentary tea and coffee bar, fresh baked cookies in the evening.

The Fairfield Inn is a very special, premium boutique oriented, historic hotel with a very fine reputation for small meetings and individual travelers in to the city. Within walking distance of nearly all of the city's attractions, the Fairfield is set in an historic building and underwent a multi-million dollar transformation with eleven stories added to a five story structure a century old. The historic façade on the exterior was kept intact and incorporated into the boutique hotel's unique design. Several elements from the original structure complement the aesthetic of the historic hotel including the original iron staircase, located in the lobby. Another historically significant point regarding the location goes back even further to the days of the American Civil War. Before Sherman burned Atlanta, he sent spies in to burn a central building to mark the target for his cannons and artillery shells. The spies set fire to the building on this spot in 1864.

Registration: Registration will be located outside the conference room on Tuesday at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Schedule: *The Advanced Seminar* runs from 8:30 a.m. to approximately 4:30 p.m. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a longer break for lunch.

Meals: Light morning fare and an afternoon snack are provided. The cost of this food is included in your registration fee. All other meals are on your own.

Attire for Training Course: Attire for the course is casual. Also, please keep in mind that hotel meeting rooms tend to be cool, so plan to bring a sweater or jacket.

Cancellations: Registrants who cancel at least 14 days prior to the start of the course will receive a full refund minus a 15% processing fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the start of the course; however, substitutions may be made at no cost up until three days before the course begins. All cancellations must be made in writing.
