

106 Essentials Course: Boise, ID

“The Section 106 Essentials” course will be held on Tuesday, June 12 and Wednesday, June 13, 2007.

Important note: Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

Registration: For individuals paying by credit card or check, on-line registration is available and can be accessed at www.achp.gov/106essentials.html. For group registrations and for individuals paying by SF 182, registration forms must be downloaded at www.achp.gov/106essentials.html and faxed to 202-606-8521.

Course Location and Accommodations: The course is being held at the Grove Hotel, 245 South Capitol Blvd, Boise, ID 83702. Website: www.grovehotelboise.com.

A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Monday, June 11 and Tuesday, June 12 for the rate of \$99 plus applicable taxes (13%). **It is recommended that you reserve your room early, as they are likely to sell out.**


Reservations must be made by May 12, 2007. Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. Check in is at 3:00 pm and checkout is at 11:00 am. **To reserve your room**, call the hotel directly at 1-888-961-5000 and state that you are with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation Section 106 Essentials Course. If our hotel block is sold out, you may find additional hotels at on-line hotel booking websites. Searching for sites for Boise ID in zip code 83702 is recommended.

Travel to Boise, ID:



The Boise Airport (<http://boiseairport.com/>) is 4 miles and 10 minutes from the Grove Hotel.

- **Ground Transportation:** Ground Transportation services from the airport are located on the lower level roadway outside baggage claim. Taxis, shuttles, buses and rental cars are available.
- **Directions from I-84 and the airport to the Grove Hotel:**
Take the vista/airport Exit (exit 53); go north on Vista to Capitol Blvd; go north on Capitol Blvd. Approximately 1 mile. The hotel is located on the corner of Front Street and Capitol Blvd., on the left-hand side of Capitol.



Parking at the Grove Hotel: Guest's overnight self-service parking is \$4.95; valet parking is available for \$12.95 per day. Meeting attendees who are not guests of the Hotel are charged \$1.50 an hour up to a maximum of \$12.00 per day for parking.

Local Information: The Grove Hotel is centrally located in downtown Boise, Idaho and is Boise's only AAA Four-Diamond rated hotel. The Grove Hotel Boise is just steps away from shopping, restaurants, and other local businesses. Part of The Grove Hotel complex is the adjacent [Qwest Arena of Idaho](#). Dubbed "Idaho's Premier Events and Attractions Showplace," it is the newest indoor sports and event center in the Northwest. Local area attractions include the Idaho Historical Museum, The Basque Museum; the Old Idaho Penitentiary State Historic Site, and the Idaho Botanical Garden, Morrison-Knudsen Nature Center, Idaho Anne Frank Human Rights Memorial, Idaho Black History Museum and the World Center for Birds of Prey. Of special interest to Section 106 Essentials Course attendees are walking tours of Historic Boise.

Registration:

Registration will be located at the Grove Hotel on Tuesday, June 12 at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Schedule:

The *Section 106 Essentials* course runs from 8:30 am to approximately 4:30 pm each day. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon. There will be a break for lunch, which is on your own.

Meals:

Light morning fare will be provided each morning along with an afternoon break each day. The cost of these food functions is included in the registration fee. All other meals are on your own.

Attire for Training Course:

Attire for the course is casual. Also, please keep in mind that hotel meeting rooms tend to be cool, so plan to bring a sweater or jacket.

Cancellations:

If made at least 14 days prior to the start of the course, registrants who cancel will receive a full refund minus a 15% processing fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the start of the course; however, substitutions may be made at no cost up until three days before the course begins. All cancellations must be made in writing.
