## *What federal agencies need to know*

### **What's happening?**

A discussion with Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) staff regarding what federal agencies need to do to initiate, conduct, and complete the historic preservation review process required by Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. Recovery money will not flow unless this process is completed.
