

106 Essentials Course: Tempe, Arizona

“The Section 106 Essentials” course will be held on Tuesday, February 6 and Wednesday, February 7, 2007.

Important note: Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of paid registrations received at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

Registration: For individuals paying by credit card or check, on-line registration is available and can be accessed at www.achp.gov/106essentials.html. For group registrations and for individuals paying by SF 182, registration forms must be downloaded at www.achp.gov/106essentials.html and faxed to 202-606-8521.

Course Location and Accommodations: The course is being held at the **Fiesta Inn Resort, 2100 South Priest Drive, Tempe, AZ 85282**. Website: <http://www.fiestainnresort.com>.

A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Monday and Tuesday nights for the government rate of \$141 for a single occupancy plus applicable occupancy tax. **You will want to make your hotel reservations early, as they are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by January 15, 2007.** Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. Check in is at 3:00 pm and checkout is at 1:00 pm. **To reserve your room**, call the hotel directly at 800-528-6481 and state that you are with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation Section 106 Essentials Course. If our hotel block is sold out, you may find additional hotels at on-line hotel booking websites. Searching for sites for Tempe, AZ in zip code 85272 is recommended.

Travel to Tempe, AZ:

Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport: The Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport is only 4.5 miles and 10 minutes from the Fiesta Inn Resort. Specific information can be found at www.phoenix.gov/AVIATION.

- **Ground Transportation:** Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport offers a variety of transportation options, including taxi, rental cars and shuttles.
 - The Fiesta Resort Inn offers complimentary airport shuttle service to the Inn. Pick up the courtesy phone next to the baggage claim and dial 16. You'll be connected to the hotel and tell them you need pick-up. Shuttle operates each half hour.
 - Taxi - Cab fare to the hotel is approximately \$10-\$15 and takes about 10 minutes.
 - SuperShuttle - Operates 24 hours a day on a time scheduled basis. It offers airport-to-door service. Vans depart at least every 15 minutes to all areas of the Valley from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. with lesser frequencies from 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Fare to the hotel is \$12.

Driving Directions to Fiesta Inn Resort:

- **From the Airport:** Take the 202 East exit to Priest Drive, where the airport exit merges with the 202 Highway. Turn right (South) at Priest Drive, and drive two miles to Broadway Road. The Fiesta Inn is located on the southwest corner of Priest and Broadway. The entrance is on your right, after the intersection.
- **From the North:** Take I-17 South to I-10 East. Exit Broadway/48th St. Go straight through the first light, and make a left at the second light, which is Broadway. Make a right on Priest Dr. The Fiesta Inn is on the right side on the southwest corner.
- **From the South:** Take I-10 West and exit Broadway/48th St. Go straight through the first light, and make a left at the second light, which is Broadway. Make a right on Priest Dr. The Fiesta Inn is on the right side on the southwest corner.
- **From the West:** Take I-10 East and exit Broadway/48th St. Go straight through the first light, and make a left at the second light, which is Broadway. Make a right on Priest Dr. The Fiesta Inn is on the right side on the southwest corner.

- **From the East:** Take Superstition Freeway (US60) West. Exit Priest Dr. Make a right onto Priest. The Fiesta Inn is on the right side on the southwest corner.

Parking at the Fiesta Resort Inn: Complimentary parking is available.



Local Information: The Fiesta Inn Resort is ideally located between Phoenix and Scottsdale, and places you near a colorful menu of things to see and do in this Southwestern Arizona. It offers 270 newly refurbished Southwestern-style guest rooms, complimentary high-speed Internet access and a recreation center among other amenities. Minutes from the Phoenix Historical Museum, Arizona State University, the Phoenix Zoo, the Desert Botanical Gardens, and the Arizona Mill Outlet Mall.

Registration:

Registration will be located at the Fiesta Inn Resort on Tuesday, February 6 at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Schedule:

The Section 106 Essentials course runs from 8:30 am to approximately 4:30 pm each day. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon. There will be a break for lunch, which is on your own.

Meals:

Light morning fare will be provided each morning along with an afternoon break each day. The cost of these food functions is included in the registration fee. All other meals are on your own.

Attire for Training Course:

Attire for the course is casual. Also, please keep in mind that hotel meeting rooms tend to be cool, so plan to bring a sweater or jacket.

Cancellations:

If made at least 14 days prior to the start of the course, registrants who cancel will receive a full refund minus a 15% processing fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the start of the course; however, substitutions may be made at no cost up until three days before the course begins. All cancellations must be made in writing.
