## **XVI. EXECUTION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF AGREEMENT**

- A. This Agreement shall be executed in counterpart, with a separate page for each signatory, and when combined will constitute the whole agreement. CBP shall ensure that each Party is provided with a fully executed copy. This Agreement will become effective off tribal lands in Arizona, California, New Mexico, and Texas on the date of the last signature by CBP, the SHPO for each of those states, GSA, USDA, DOI, USIBWC, the New Mexico State Land Office, and the ACHP.
- B. This Agreement will become effective on tribal lands when executed by the CBP, GSA, USDA, DOI, USIBWC, the ACHP, and the appropriate tribal officials of the relevant tribe from the California Valley Miwok Tribe, the Cocopah Indian Tribe, the Delaware Nation, the Fort Yuma-Quechan Tribe, the Pechanga Band of Luiseno Mission Indians, the Rincon Band of Luiseno Mission Indians, the Tohono O'odham Nation, the Tonkawa Tribe of Oklahoma, and the Yavapai-Prescott Indian Tribe.
- C. Additional Federal departments or State agencies may be included in this Agreement as a Signatory without its amendment if CBP notifies the current signatories in writing of the proposal and there is no objection from the current signatories within 30 days of CBP's written notice. If no response is received within 30 days, CBP may assume concurrence with the addition of the Federal department or State agency to this Agreement. CBP shall ensure that each Party is provided with an updated copy of the Agreement.
- D. Additional THPOs and Tribes may be included in this Agreement as either a Signatory or concurring party without its amendment if CBP notifies the current signatories in writing of the proposal and there is no objection from the current signatories within 30 days of CBP's written notice. If no response is received within 30 days, CBP may assume concurrence with the addition of the THPO or Tribe to this Agreement. CBP shall ensure that each consulting party is provided with an updated copy of the Agreement.

**EXECUTION AND IMPLEMENTATION** of this Agreement by CBP; the SHPOs of Arizona, California, New Mexico, and Texas; GSA; USDA; DOI; USIBWC; New Mexico State Land Office; the Tribal governments of the California Valley Miwok Tribe, the Cocopah Indian Tribe, the Delaware Nation, the Fort Yuma-Quechan Tribe, the Pechanga Band of Luiseno Mission Indians, the Rincon Band of Luiseno Mission Indians, the Tohono O'odham Nation, the Tonkawa Tribe of Oklahoma, and the Yavapai-Prescott Indian Tribe; and the ACHP evidences that CBP has satisfied its Section 106 responsibilities, and any corresponding responsibilities for the signatories to this agreement, for its programs in states located along the Southwest Border of the United States.
