

**AMENDMENT TO
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY
ADMINISTRATION AND THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
REGARDING THE REPLACEMENT OF THE OAKVILLE CROSS ROAD
BRIDGE (21C-069) IN NAPA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA**

WHEREAS, the Agreement was fully executed on August 24, 2005;

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has assigned and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans, including all subordinate divisions defined below) has assumed FHWA responsibility for environmental review, consultation, and coordination pursuant to 23 USC 327, which became effective on October 1, 2012 and applies to this undertaking; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans District 4 and the Napa County Department of Public Works have requested an extension of time relative to the completion of data recovery documentation required by Stipulation III of the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation VI of the Agreement, Caltrans on behalf of the Federal Highway Administration and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

Pursuant to Section VII of the MOA, this agreement document is extended an additional one calendar year.
