

Prototype PA Draft Table of Contents

Preamble

Key clauses:

- Identification of types of undertakings addressed by the PA
- Determination that PA purpose is to streamline/expedite Section 106 review
- Statement that formal adoption of PA prototype by ACHP means ACHP will not participate in individual state specific PA development
- Statement that FEMA undertakings may result in individual projects with potential to affect historic properties that may have cultural significance to Federally recognized Indian Tribes on and off Tribal lands
- Statement that FEMA has identified Tribes with tribal lands and/or tribal interests in the state and has engaged in government-to-government consultation with these Tribes and invited them to enter into the Agreement
- Acknowledgement by all Signatory Parties that PA will allow for more efficient implementation of FEMA programs given streamlined reviews specified in the stipulations

General – to include:

- Applicability
- Lead Agencies
- Roles and Responsibilities (maintain contact information assigned here)
- Curation of Artifacts
- Public Participation
- Timeframes (differentiate between emergency, disaster, and standard with range of time for each to be negotiated at state levels)

Coordination

- distinguish between disaster and non-disaster coordination

Project Reviews

- Changes to Approved Scope of Work
- Anticipatory Actions
- Unexpected Discoveries
- Curation of Artifacts
- Allowances
- Emergencies = 72 hrs or less
- Standard = shortened / 30 days

Resolution of Adverse Effects to Historic Properties
