

**2nd AMENDMENT TO
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
AMONG
THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY
THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
AND THE LOUISIANA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER
REGARDING THE DEMOLITION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF
THE YWCA MAIN BUILDING, 601 SOUTH JEFFERSON DAVIS PKWY.
NEW ORLEANS, LA**

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) Regarding the Demolition and Reconstruction of the YWCA Main Building, 602 South Jefferson Davis Pkwy., New Orleans, LA (Undertaking) was executed on October 2, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) of the Department of Homeland Security, in consultation with the Consulting Parties, executed a 1st Amendment to the MOA (1st AMOA) on January 4, 2013 that extended the duration date provided in the MOA to December 31, 2014; updated the status of the reviews required by the MOA; and documented the mitigation measures required by the MOA that had been completed; and

WHEREAS, FEMA determined that it is necessary to execute a 2nd Amendment to the MOA (2nd AMOA) to extend the duration date of the MOA in order to allow additional time to keep in force the provisions of Stipulation V for changes to the Scope of Work and Stipulation VI for the treatment of discoveries while the YWCA of New Orleans takes steps to implement the Undertaking;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation X of the MOA, FEMA, the Louisiana State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP), the YWCA of New Orleans, the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP), the Preservation Resource Center of New Orleans (PRC), and the Mid-City Neighborhood Organization (MCNO) agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Amend Stipulation XI in its entirety so it reads as follows:

Unless amended or terminated in accordance with Stipulation X, this MOA will remain in effect through December 31, 2016, or until FEMA determines that it has been satisfactorily fulfilled. The YWCA will notify GOHSEP and FEMA when the Undertaking is completed, and FEMA will notify the Signatories, Invited Signatory, and Concurring Parties by e-mail when it determines that the construction of the new facility is completed and opportunities for changes to the scope of work described in Stipulation V, or discoveries or unexpected events described in Stipulation VI are unlikely, thereby fulfilling the terms of the MOA and its 1st AMOA and 2nd AMOA.

EXECUTION AND IMPLEMENTATION of this 2nd AMOA regarding the Demolition and Reconstruction of the YWCA Main Building, 602 South Jefferson Davis Pkwy., New Orleans,

LA evidences that FEMA has afforded ACHP a reasonable opportunity to comment on the Undertaking and its effects on historic properties, that FEMA has taken into account the effects of the Undertaking on historic properties and satisfied its responsibilities under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and applicable implementing regulations.
