

**AMENDMENT TO THE PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT
AMONG
THE MICHIGAN STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER,
THE CITY OF DETROIT, MICHIGAN AND
THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
REGARDING ADMINISTRATION OF THE
HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS
FUNDED BY THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT
(AGREEMENT)**

WHEREAS, the Agreement was executed on November 24, 2015;

WHEREAS, since the execution of the Agreement, the development of a more comprehensive agreement has been ongoing with all signatories and other relevant stakeholders per Stipulation XV of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, since the execution of the Agreement, an amendment was approved and executed on December 24, 2015 to extend the expiration date to June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, substantial progress has been made on the development of this comprehensive agreement, however the agreement will not be ready for execution by the expiration of the current Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation XVI of the Agreement, the City, the SHPO, and the ACHP agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Amend Stipulation XIV so it reads as follows:

The Agreement shall take effect on the date it is signed by all parties and shall continue in full force and effect until December 31, 2016, unless otherwise terminated or extended. At any time prior to this date the City may request from the SHPO in writing that it enter into consultation in order to make modifications to this Agreement so that it might be improved/updated. No extension modification shall be effective unless all parties to the Agreement have agreed to it in writing.


And

2. Amend Stipulation XV so it reads as follows:

Within 60 days of executing this Agreement, the parties to this Agreement and other relevant stakeholders shall initiate consultation to establish priorities and develop a plan/strategy which shall result in a more streamlined and effective historic preservation review process. The process will reflect best practices in technology, staffing, methodology, policies and protocols, and shall be incorporated into the development of a new improved Programmatic Agreement, which shall be executed on or before December 31, 2016.


