WHEREAS, evaluation of the first year of the Agreement has led signatory parties to propose changes to the Agreement to enhance compliance with Section 106 and to extend its duration and scope; and

WHEREAS, the signatories to Appendix D have had an opportunity to review those changes to the Agreement and concur that they will benefit from the implementation of the Agreement by NYCOMB for the administration of CDBG-DR funds related to Hurricane Sandy and CDBG-DR appropriations for future federally-declared disasters affecting New York City; and,

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation IV.A.1. of the Agreement, the signatories to Appendix D accept the terms and conditions of the amended Agreement (attached), and as appropriate under 24 CFR 58, NYCOMB shall follow the amended Agreement and thereby take into account the effect of its undertakings and satisfy its Section 106 responsibilities for the CDBG-DR program for activities in New York City.
