


# 106 Essentials Course: Mobile, AL

“The Section 106 Essentials” course will be held on Tuesday, April 5 and Wednesday, April 6, 2011.

**Important note:** Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

**Registration:** For individuals paying by credit card, [on-line registration is available](#). For individuals paying by check or SF 182, [download the registration form](#) and fax to 202-606-5073. For those registering as a group, [download the group registration form](#) and fax to 202-606-5073.

**Course Location and Accommodations:** The course is being held at the Renaissance Mobile Riverview Plaza Hotel, 64 South Water Street Mobile, AL, 36602. ([www.renaissancehotels.com/mobrv](http://www.renaissancehotels.com/mobrv)). A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Monday and Tuesday, April 4 and 5 at the government rate of \$100 for a single occupancy plus applicable state and local tax (14%). **It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by March 7, 2011.** Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. **To reserve your room**, call the reservation department at 1-800-922-3298 and state that you are with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation – Section 106 Essentials and ask for the rate of \$100.



**Traveling to Mobile:** The Mobile Regional Airport (<http://www.mobairport.com/>) is 14 miles from the Riverview Plaza. The Pensacola Gulf Coast Airport (<http://www.flypensacola.com/>) is 57 miles from Mobile.

**Ground Transportation** from Mobile Regional Airport: Taxi fare: \$26; Mobile Bay Transportation (reservations required) (<http://www.mobilebaytransportation.com/>) fare: \$20.

**Parking:** On-site parking, fee: \$12 daily; Valet parking, fee: \$17 daily

**Hotel and Local Information:** The Renaissance Riverview is in the heart of the revitalized downtown area and overlooks Mobile Bay. If you have time while in Mobile, you may want to visit Historic Mobile Preservation Society (<http://www.historicmobile.org/>). It is approximately a mile and a half from the hotel.

**Registration:** Registration will be located outside the conference room on Tuesday, April 5 at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

**Schedule:** *The Section 106 Essentials* course runs from 8:30 a.m. to approximately 4:30 p.m. each day. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a longer break for lunch.

**Meals:** Light morning fare and an afternoon snack are provided each day. The cost of this food is included in your registration fee. All other meals are on your own.

**Attire for Training Course:** Attire for the course is casual. Also, please keep in mind that hotel meeting rooms tend to be cool, so plan to bring a sweater or jacket.

**Cancellations:** Registrants who cancel at least 14 days prior to the start of the course will receive a full refund minus a 15% processing fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the start of the course; however, substitutions may be made at no cost up until three days before the course begins. All cancellations must be made in writing.
