

Advanced Section 106 Seminar: Tucson, Arizona

The Section 106 Advanced Seminar will be held on Wednesday, March 10, 2010

Important note: Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

Course Location and Accommodations: The course will take place at the Westward Look Resort, 245 East Ina Road, Tucson, AZ 85704. <http://www.westwardlook.com>. The Westward Look Resort is set high into the Catalina Foothills, just due north of the city of Tucson. Perhaps the most compelling aspect of the Westward Look is its historical significance. This hotel began as a family home in 1912, grew into a thriving dude ranch, and now a full-service resort.

A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Tuesday, March 9 for the government rate of \$124 for a single/double occupancy plus applicable state and local tax (12.59%). **It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by Sunday, February 7.** Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. **To reserve your room**, call 1-800-772-2500 or you may email at reservations@westwardlook.com. State that you are with the ACHP - Section 106 Advanced and ask for the rate of \$124. If our room block is sold out, you can find additional hotels at online hotel booking Websites. Searching for hotels in the Tucson zip code 85704 is recommended.

Traveling to Tucson:


Tucson International Airport, <http://www.tucsonairport.org/index.html>, is approximately 40 minutes to the resort.

Taxi fare from the airport is approximately \$40 one-way.

Driving Directions from the Tucson International Airport: Exit the airport and follow signs for I-10; exit onto I-10 West towards Phoenix; Stay on I-10 West for 10 miles to Ina Road, exit 246. Turn right onto Ina Road. Head east for 6 miles to Westward Look Drive, and turn left at the stoplight.

Sky Harbor International Airport, <http://www.phoenix.gov/AVIATION>, is 99 miles to resort, but it has more flights and connections. Westward Look Resort is an easy drive from the Phoenix Airport on I-10 to Ina Road, then six miles to Westward Look Drive.

Driving Directions from Sky Harbor International Airport: Turn right onto Sky Harbor Blvd; Turn left onto East Buckeye Road; turn left onto 24th St, turn left to I-10 East. Take exit 248 onto Ina Road. Head east for 6 miles to Westward Look Drive, and turn left at the stoplight.



Parking Rates at Hotel: There is no charge for parking.

Local Information: Located on 80-acres of limitless desert land, Westward Look Resort is a true desert oasis. Built in the early 1900s, the resort is flawlessly set at the base of the striking Santa Catalina Mountains. The city grew along the Santa Cruz and Rillito rivers, where native peoples grew corn beans and squash since pre-historic times. This desert valley is surrounded by mountains known as "Sky Islands." Registration: Registration will be located outside the conference room on Wednesday, March 10 at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Schedule: *The Advanced 106 Seminar* runs from 8:30 am to approximately 4:30 pm. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a longer break for lunch.

Meals: Light morning fare and an afternoon snack are provided. The cost of this food is included in your registration fee. All other meals are on your own.
