

Advanced Section 106 Seminar: San Diego, CA

The Section 106 Advanced Seminar will be held on Friday, June 18, 2010

Important note: Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

Course Location and Accommodations: The course will take place at The US Grant Hotel, 326 Broadway, San Diego, CA 92101. <http://www.starwoodhotels.com/luxury/property/overview/index.html?propertyID=1488>. On the National Registry of Historic Places for 20 years, the hotel was built in 1910 and has an interesting history. 4 U.S. Presidents have stayed at the hotel.

A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Thursday, June 17 for the government rate of \$147 plus applicable state and local tax (12.56%). **It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by Tuesday, May 18.** Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. **To reserve your room**, call 866-837-4270 and state that you are with the ACHP Section 106 Essentials San Diego Advanced Seminar. If our room block is sold out, you can find additional hotels at online hotel booking Websites. Searching for hotels in the San Diego zip code 92101 is recommended.

Parking Rates at Hotel: Valet parking is available at \$15 a day or \$32 overnight.

The hotel is in the historic Gaslamp Quarter, which was named for the gas lamps that lined the streets. The historic district includes 94 historic buildings in the 16 and one-half block area. Many buildings are Victorian Era themed, and are still in use with active tenants including 100 places to eat, 100 shops and 35 nightclubs.

Registration: Registration will be located outside the conference room on Friday at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Schedule: *The Advanced 106 Seminar* runs from 8:30 am to approximately 4:30 pm. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a longer break for lunch.

Meals: Light morning fare and an afternoon snack are provided. The cost of this food is included in your registration fee. All other meals are on your own.

Attire for Training Course: Attire for the course is casual. Also, please keep in mind that hotel meeting rooms tend to be cool, so plan to bring a sweater or jacket.

Cancellations: Registrants who cancel at least 14 days prior to the start of the course will receive a full refund minus a 15% processing fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the start of the course; however, substitutions may be made at no cost up until three days before the course begins. All cancellations must be made in writing.
