

Advanced Section 106 Seminar: Savannah, GA

The Section 106 Advanced Seminar will be held on Tuesday, March 24, 2009

Important note: Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

Registration: For individuals paying by credit card, on-line registration is available and can be accessed at <http://www.achp.gov/106advanced.html>. For group registrations and for individuals paying by check or SF 182, registration forms must be downloaded at <http://www.achp.gov/106advanced.html> and faxed to 202-606-5073.

Course Location and Accommodations: The course is being held at the Inn at Ellis Square, 201 West Bay Street, Savannah, GA 31401. <http://www.innatellissquare.com/>. This historic hotel is located in the recently renovated Guckenheimer Building and was honored with the Historic Preservation Award in 2006 by the Historic Savannah Foundation.

A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Monday, March 23, for the government rate of \$108 for a single occupancy plus applicable state and local tax (13%). **It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by February 23, 2009.** Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. **To reserve your room**, call 1-877-542-7666 and state that you are with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation. If our room block is sold out, you can find additional hotels at online hotel booking websites. Searching for sites for Savannah in zip code 31401 is recommended.

Traveling to Savannah: The Savannah/Hilton Head International Airport connects with 16 non-stop destinations. 
Airport Ground Transportation:

Local Information: The Inn at Ellis Square is located in the heart of Savannah's picturesque Historic Riverfront District. Few cities in America rival the historic significance or the elegant beauty of Savannah. Most attractions of interest can be visited simply by walking among the stately Savannah, Georgia squares. The Savannah, GA Historic District lies right outside the doors of the Inn at Ellis Square. From horse-and-carriage rides to walking and ghost tours, one of our nation's richest historic troves is waiting for you to discover it. The Ellis Square Project, adjacent to the hotel, is the redevelopment of one of the six original squares laid out by Georgia founder James Oglethorpe.



Registration: Registration will be located outside the conference room on Tuesday at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Schedule: *The Advanced 106 Seminar* runs from 8:30 am to approximately 4:30 pm. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a break for lunch.
