

106 Advanced Seminar: Minneapolis, MN

The Section 106 Advanced Seminar will be held on Thursday, June 9, 2011


Important note: Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

Course Location and Accommodations: The course is being held at the historic Hotel Ivy, 201 South 11th Street, Minneapolis, MN 55403. Website:

A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Wednesday, June 8 for the rate of \$137 plus applicable taxes (13.4%). **It is recommended that you reserve your room early, as they are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by May 18, 2011.** Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. Check in is at 3:00 pm and checkout is at 11:00 am. **To reserve your room**, call 1-877-746-6001 and state you are with ACHP Section 106 Advanced.



Traveling to Minneapolis: You can travel to Minneapolis by air or Amtrak. The Minneapolis/St Paul International Airport (www.mspairport.com/) is 12.28 miles and approximately 18 minutes from the Hotel Ivy. Amtrak's Midway Station is 12 miles from the hotel. Taxi rate to the hotel: \$25.

Directions from the airport to the hotel:

Keep straight onto Glumack Dr; Take ramp left for SR-5 East toward Minneapolis / St Paul; Take ramp right for SR-55 West / The Great River Rd toward Minneapolis; Keep straight onto SR-62 West; Take ramp right for I-35W North toward Minneapolis; At exit 16A, take ramp left for SR-65 North toward Downtown Exits; Take ramp right and follow signs for 11th St / E Grant St; Bear left onto 11th St S; Keep straight onto S 11th St.

Ground Transportation: Ground Transportation services from the airport are located on the lower level roadway outside baggage claim. Taxis, shuttles, buses and rental cars are available.

- **City Rail System:** Minneapolis' train, The Hiawatha Line, offers a fast, quiet light-rail service to 17 stations between downtown Minneapolis, Mall of America, and Minneapolis - St. Paul International Airport (MSP). The basic fare for the light-rail is \$1.50 and \$2 during rush hour (9am – 5pm). The last train runs at 1am from all locations. Hotel Ivy guests exit at the Nicollet Mall stop. From this point, take one of the waiting taxis to the hotel, 6 blocks south.

Parking at the Hotel Ivy: The hotel offers valet parking day rate of \$8 and an overnight rate of \$28. Parking is also available on Leamington Ramp which is located across the street from the hotel on 2nd and 11th. Fees vary, approximately \$9.00.

Local Information: A historic landmark in the heart of downtown Minneapolis, the Hotel Ivy captivates with Ziggurat style and seven miles of skyway. Even before the first blueprints were brought to fruition, it was clear that Minneapolis's Ivy Tower was destined to be different. In both form and function, the tower contrasted greatly from the popular skyscrapers going up at a rapid rate throughout the country. The Ivy Tower was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1986, a flag it flies with honor today. Located in downtown Minneapolis, Hotel Ivy connects to a skyway that makes it easy to get anywhere, any time of the year. Hotel Ivy is just minutes away from downtown Minneapolis's entertainment mecca, Block E, and world-renowned Guthrie Theater. The Hotel Ivy is located just 8 miles from the Mall of America.

Registration:

Registration will be located outside the conference room Thursday, June 9 at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Schedule: *Advanced 106 Seminar* runs from 8:30 am to approximately 4:30 pm. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a longer break for lunch.

Meals: Light morning fare and an afternoon snack are provided. The cost of this food is included in your registration fee. All other meals are on your own.

Attire for Training Course: Attire for the course is casual. Also, please keep in mind that hotel meeting rooms tend to be cool, so plan to bring a sweater or jacket.

Cancellations: Registrants who cancel at least 14 days prior to the start of the course will receive a full refund minus a 15% processing fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the start of the course; however, substitutions may be made at no cost up until three days before the course begins. All cancellations must be made in writing.
