“The Section 106 Essentials” course will be held on Wednesday, August 18 and Thursday, August 19, 2010

Important note: Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

Course Location and Accommodations: The course will take place at the Centennial Hotel, 96 Pleasant Street, Concord, NH 03301 <http://www.thecentennialhotel.com>. The hotel is a historic landmark hotel in downtown Concord.


A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Tuesday, August 17 and Wednesday, August 18 at the government rate of \$94 plus applicable state and local tax (9%). **It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by July 17, 2010.** Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. **To reserve your room**, call 603-227-9000 or email to reservations@thecentennialhotel.com. State that you are with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation and ask for the rate of \$94. If our room block is sold out, you can find additional hotels at online hotel booking Websites. Searching for hotels in the Concord zip code 03301 is recommended.

Traveling to Concord: The airport serving Concord is the Manchester Boston Regional Airport, www.flymanchester.com. It is approximately 20 miles the hotel.

Local Information: The Centennial is located within minutes of a variety of things to do in New Hampshire. Arts & culture, historic sites, science & nature and health activities abound. Nearby historic sites include Canterbury Shaker Village, Franklin Pierce Homestead, NH State House and Visitors' Center and Pierce Manse. There is a self-guided downtown walking tour of more than 50 historic sites, including the State House, New Hampshire Historical Society, First Baptist Church, Eagle Hotel, Phenix Hall, Upham-Walker House and the New Hampshire State Library. Brochures are available at the Chamber of Commerce and the Museum of New Hampshire History gift shop.

Registration will be located outside the conference room on Wednesday, August 18 at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Schedule: *The Section 106 Essentials* course runs from 8:30 a.m. to approximately 4:30 p.m. each day. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a longer break for lunch.

Meals: Light morning fare and an afternoon snack are provided each day. The cost of this food is included in your registration fee. All other meals are on your own.

Attire for Training Course: Attire for the course is casual. Also, please keep in mind that hotel meeting rooms tend to be cool, so plan to bring a sweater or jacket.

Cancellations: Registrants who cancel at least 14 days prior to the start of the course will receive a full refund minus a 15% processing fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the start of the course; however, substitutions may be made at no cost up until three days before the course begins. All cancellations must be made in writing.
