

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Veterans Administration has determined that the demolition of Building 110 at the VAMC Leavenworth, Kansas, will have an adverse effects upon a property eligible for the National register of Historic Places, and

WHEREAS, the Veterans Administration has consulted with the Kansas State Historic Preservation Officer and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation regarding appropriate means to mitigate the adverse effect.

NOW, Therefore the Veterans Administration, the Kansas State Historic Preservation Officer and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to mitigate the adverse effect.


STIPULATIONS

1. The Veterans Administration will phtographically record Building 110 to HABS standards as permanent documentation of the building.
2. The Veterans Administration will photographically record Building 33 to HABS standards to document the existing environment of the building.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement evidences that the Veterans Administration has considered the effects of this undertaking upon a National Register eligible property and has afforded the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation a reasonable opportunity to comment in accordance with section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and the Council's regulations in 36 CFR Part 800.
