

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
Demolition of Building 226 at Fort Snelling
Hennepin County, Minnesota

WHEREAS, the Veterans Administration has determined that demolition of Building 226 will have an effect upon the Fort Snelling Historic District and has consulted with the Minnesota State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) pursuant to the regulations (36 CFR Part 800) implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470f).

NOW, THEREFORE, Veterans Administration and the Minnesota State Historic Preservation Office agree that if the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) accepts this Memorandum of Agreement in accordance with 36 CFR Section 800.6(a)(1)(i), the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

Stipulations

Veterans Administration will ensure that the following measures are carried out.

The agency official shall request the National Park Service (Historic American Buildings Survey (HABS)) to determine what documentation shall be required for the property specified in this Memorandum of Agreement for demolition. The agency shall ensure that unless otherwise agreed to by the National Park Service, all documentation is completed and accepted by HABS prior to the demolition, and that an original copy of this documentation is made available to the SHPO.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement by Veterans Administration and the Minnesota State Historic Preservation Office and its subsequent acceptance by the Council and the Veterans Administration carrying out the terms of the Memorandum of Agreement evidences that Veterans Administration has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the demolition of Building 226 and its effects on historic properties and that Veterans Administration has taken into account the effects of the project on historic properties.
