MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Veterans Administration (VA), has determined that implementation of the proposed Phase II Modernization Project at Chillicothe VA Medical Center, Chillicothe, Ohio, will have an effect upon properties included in or eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places and has requested the comments of the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470) and its implementing regulations, "Protection of Historic and Cultural Properties" (36 CFR Part 800),

NOW, THEREFORE, VA, the Ohio State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), and the Council agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

Stipulations

VA will insure that the following measures are carried out.

1. Prior to undertaking any construction activities included in the Phase II Modernization Project, VA will document the current appearance and configuration of the Medical Complex and forward it to VA Central for curation. Documentation will include construction drawings, photographs, and site plans.

2. New construction and renovation activities associated with the Phase II Modernization Project will be carried out in accordance with the drawings and specifications submitted to the Council on August 27, 1982.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement evidences that VA has afforded the Council a reasonable opportunity to comment on the undertaking and its effect on historic properties and that VA has taken into account the effects of its undertaking on historic properties.
