AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AMONG THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS, TEXAS HISTORICAL COMMISSION AND THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION REGARDING THE CLINICAL EXPANSION FOR MENTAL HEALTH & LONG TERM SPINAL CORD INJURY PROJECTS AT THE VETERANS AFFAIRS NORTH TEXAS HEALTH CARE SYSTEM, DALLAS, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs North Texas Health Care System (VA) and the Texas Historical Commission (THC) and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) executed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) on January 22, 2013 to address potential adverse effects proposed by the Mental Health & Long Term Spinal Cord Injury projects at the Veterans Affairs North Texas Health Care System located in Dallas, Texas;

WHEREAS, Stipulation VI, Duration, of the MOA states that the MOA expires if its undertakings have not commenced with five years from the date of its execution unless the signatories agree in writing to an extension;

WHEREAS, these undertakings (the proposed Mental Health & Long Term Spinal Cord Injury projects) have not yet commenced due to lack of funding;

WHEREAS, the parties have determined that it is appropriate to extend the duration of the MOA so that that the terms of the MOA may be completed;

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation VI of the Memorandum of Agreement, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), Texas Historical Commission (THC) and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (AICP) agree to extend the Memorandum of Agreement scheduled to expire January 22, 2018. The current terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Agreement will remain in effect and will be extended to January 22, 2023.
