MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT


WHEREAS, the Veterans Administration (VA), has determined that the demolition of Buildings 21 and 34 at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Hampton, Virginia, will have an effect upon properties eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places and has requested the comments of the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470f) and its implementing regulations, "Protection of Historic and Cultural Properties (36 CFR Part 800),"

NOW, THEREFORE, the VA, the Virginia State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), and the Council agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulation in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

Stipulation

Buildings 21 and 34 will be recorded prior to demolition so that there will be a permanent record of their history and appearance. The Historic American Buildings Survey (HABS) (National Park Service, Department of the Interior, Washington, D.C. 20240) will first be contacted to determine what documentation is required. All documentation must be accepted in writing by HABS and the Council notified of its acceptance, prior to the demolition. Copies of this documentation will be provided to the Virginia SHPO.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement evidences that the VA has afforded the Council a reasonable opportunity to comment on the undertaking and its effects on historic properties and that the VA has taken into account the effects of its undertaking on historic properties.
