MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Veterans Administration (VA) has determined that the construction of the New Credit Union Building (Credit Union) will have an effect upon the Veterans Administration Medical Center (Center), a property eligible for the National Register of Historic Places and has requested the comments of the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470f) and its implementing regulations, "Protection of Historic and Cultural Properties" (36 CFR Part 800),


NOW, THEREFORE, the VA, the Washington State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), and the Council agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the Credit Union on the Center.

Stipulations

The VA will ensure that the following measures are carried out.

1. A landscape plan, designed to screen the Credit Union from the Center's main entrance road, will be submitted to the Washington State Historic Preservation Officer for review and approval.
2. The approved landscape plan will be implemented concurrent with construction of the Credit Union.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement evidences that the VA has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the Credit Union and its effects on the Center and that the VA has taken into account the effects of the project on the historic district.
