AMENDMENT #1 TO

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS PUGET SOUND HEALTH CARE SYSTEM AND THE WASHINGTON STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER REGARDING THE CONSTRUCTION RELATED TO BUILDING 81 SEISMIC REPLACEMENT American lake, WA

A. WHEREAS the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was executed on June 2011;

B. WHEREAS renovation of Building 18 was added to the Building 81 Seismic Replacement construction project because that renovation is required in order to relocate maintenance shops from buildings which will be demolished for Building 201 construction.

C. WHEREAS this Amendment #1 to the original June 2011 MOA modifies the MOA in order to renovate Building 18.

D. NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the Stipulation VI of the MOA, the Washington State Historic Preservation Officer (WA SHPO) and the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, VA Puget Sound Health Care System (VAPSHCS) agree:

1. That the terms, conditions, and their respective rights, duties, and obligations as contained in the preceding MOA and its exhibits are hereby deemed contained in this document as if fully restated herein, and remain in full force and effect, and amended only as and to the extent expressly stated in this Amendment #1, including but not limited to, the Stipulations below.

2. Stipulation II Paragraph F: Amend the first sentence describing when the VAPSHCS will engage WA SHPO in a dialogue regarding the long-term future of Building 81 from 'within one (1) year of the execution of this MOA' to 'prior to design of Building 81 seismic renovation'. This design is still several years away and has not yet been scheduled, so a dialogue prior to that would not be comprehensive or inclusive of all issues.

3. Stipulation II Paragraph G: Amend the first sentence describing when the VAPSHCS will develop an exhibit in Building 2 from 'within five (5) years of the execution of this MOA' to 'as part of the design and renovation of the second floor of Building 2'. This project is still several years away and the space in Building 2 has not yet been built, so the exhibit cannot yet be installed.

4. Add Stipulation II Paragraph H: 'In consultation and coordination with WA SHPO and as part of the Building 18 Renovation Project, VA Puget Sound will develop and install a permanent display on the history of the American Lake Veterans Hospital in a prominent exterior location on campus. Potential locations include at the flagpole between Buildings 81 and 8 or in the future location of the pedestrian mall at Building 201 exhibit.'

Execution of this Amendment #1 to the MOA by VAPSHCS and the WA SHPO and implementation of its terms evidence that VA Puget Sound has taken into account the effects of the undertaking on historic properties and provided the WA SHPO an opportunity to comment.
