

106 Agreements Seminar: Anchorage, AK – October 10, 2019

Registration: Payment may be made by online credit card registration or by check or SF 182. Go to: <https://www.achp.gov/training/classroom> to register.

Course Location and Accommodations: The course will take place at The Lakefront Hotel, 4800 Spenard Road, Anchorage, AK (<https://www.millenniumhotels.com/en/anchorage/the-lakefront-anchorage/?cid=gplaces-the-lakefront-anchorage>). A block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Monday-Thursday, October 7-10, at the government rate of \$99 for a single occupancy, plus applicable state and local taxes. It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms may sell out. **Reservations must be made by Friday, September 6, 2019.** Reservations made after that date will be accepted on availability and at the prevailing rate at the time of the reservation.

Hotel and Local Information: The Lakefront Hotel is set on the shore of Lake Spenard next to Lake Hood. It is the only hotel in Anchorage located on a lake. The scenic hotel has daily flightseeing and fishing pickups from its own dock, from which you can also gaze at floatplanes with the majestic Chugach Mountains behind. The hotel is conveniently located near Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport, with downtown Anchorage just four miles away.

Transportation:

This hotel is 1 mile from the airport and 4 miles from downtown Anchorage. Complimentary 24-hour airport shuttle service is available.

Parking at Hotel: Complimentary for guests.

Registration: Registration will be located outside the conference room on Thursday at 8 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Schedule: *The Section 106 Agreements Seminar* runs from 8:30 a.m. to approximately 4:30 p.m. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a longer break for lunch.

Meals: Light morning fare and an afternoon snack are provided. The cost of this food is included in your registration fee. All other meals are on your own.
