

# Section 106 Agreements Seminar: Boise, ID – August 6, 2020

“The Section 106 Agreements Seminar” will be on Thursday, August 6, 2020.

**Course Location and Accommodations:** The course is being held at [Hyatt Place Hotel](#), 1024 W. Bannock Street, Boise, ID 83702. A block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Monday - Wednesday, August 3-5, at the government rate of \$137.00 for a single occupancy plus applicable state and local taxes. Individual cancellations must be made 48 hours prior to arrival. Any cancellations within 48 hours of arrival or no-shows will be subject to a charge of one night's room and tax.

Due date for reservations is **Friday, July 3, 2020**. Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation.

**Hotel and Local Information:** Hyatt Place Boise/Downtown is the perfect home base for exploring the western hub of Boise, Idaho. It is situated in the heart of the city, just a few minutes from attractions such as Boise State University and the Idaho State Capitol.
