D. A Responsible Agency may close out its role in the PA and withdraw from further participation in the implementation of the PA's terms effective once it has completed all of its responsibilities as identified in the PA, notified the other Signatories and Consulting Parties to that effect in writing, and resolved, in accordance with Stipulation X, those written objections to the notification that were raised within 30 days of receipt of the notification, if any. The notice will include a final semi-annual Interim Progress Report as described in Stipulation XI.C. A withdrawal by a Responsible Agency does not affect the responsibilities of any other Responsible Agency. A withdrawn Responsible Agency has satisfied its responsibilities under Section 106 for the Undertaking and has no further rights or responsibilities under the PA.

66 EXECUTION AND IMPLEMENTATION of this Second Amendment to the PA changes 67 no other terms of the PA and evidences that the Responsible Agencies have afforded ACHP a 68 reasonable opportunity to comment on the Undertaking and its effects on historic properties; 69 taken into account the effects of the Undertaking on historic properties; and have satisfied 67 their responsibilities under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and 68 applicable implementing regulations.
