

**AMENDMENT TO
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
AMONG THE
DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS, NATIONAL CEMETERY ADMINISTRATION,
GEORGIA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER,
AND THE
ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
REGARDING DEMOLITION OF A HISTORIC RESOURCE
AND CONSTRUCTION OF
A NEW RESTROOM FACILITY AT
MARIETTA NATIONAL CEMETERY, COBB COUNTY, MARIETTA, GEORGIA
(HP # 140916-003)**

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement among the Department of Veterans Affairs, National Cemetery Administration, Georgia State Historic Preservation Officer, and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation regarding Demolition of a Historic Resource and Construction of a New Restroom Facility at Marietta National Cemetery, Cobb County, Marietta, Georgia (MOA) was executed April 28, 2016 and pursuant to Stipulation 9. was stipulated to be in effect until April 28, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), National Cemetery Administration (NCA), Marietta National Cemetery has identified a need to extend the duration of the MOA to allow additional time to complete the terms of the MOA; and

WHEREAS, the signatories have determined that it is appropriate to extend the duration of the MOA so that the terms of the MOA may be completed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Stipulation 9. of the MOA, the signatories have agreed that the MOA should be amended to extend its duration an additional two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, NCA will send a copy of this executed amendment to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP);

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation 12. of the MOA, NCA and the Georgia State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) agree to amend the MOA as follows:

Amend Stipulation 9. so it reads as follows:

9. DURATION/RENEWAL: This MOA will remain in effect from two (2) years from the execution of this amendment, unless it is closed out, amended, or terminated prior to that date. No later than six (6) months prior to expiration of the MOA, NCA may initiate consultation with the signatories to determine if the MOA should be allowed to expire or whether it should be extended for an additional term via an amendment pursuant to Stipulation 12.

All remaining stipulations remain in full force and effect.
