

AMENDMENT #2 TO
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS
PUGET SOUND HEALTH CARE SYSTEM
AND THE WASHINGTON STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER
REGARDING THE CONSTRUCTION RELATED TO
BUILDING 81 SEISMIC REPLACEMENT
AMERICAN LAKE, WA

WHEREAS, the *Memorandum of Agreement between the United States Department of Veterans Affairs [VA] Puget Sound Health Care System and the Washington State Historic Preservation Officer [SHPO] regarding the Construction related to Building 81 Seismic Replacement American Lake, WA* (MOA) was executed June 7, 2011 and amended December 11, 2015, and pursuant to Stipulation IV (Duration) was stipulated to be in effect until June 7, 2021; and

WHEREAS, VA Puget Sound Health Care System (VAPSHCS) has identified a need to extend the duration of the MOA to allow additional time to complete the terms of the MOA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Stipulation I (Project Phasing) the actions still pending are the construction of Building 201 and the demolition of Bldgs 24, 27, 50, 86, 132, 150, 151, 156, T97; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Stipulation II (Documentation) the actions still pending are documenting buildings in accordance with The Washington State Standards for Cultural Resource Reporting; providing for design review of the new Building 201; providing for input into the long-range planning for Building 81; developing an exhibit on the history of the American Lake Veterans Hospital to be displayed in Building 2; and developing an exterior display on the history of the American Lake Veterans Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the signatories have determined that it is appropriate to extend the duration of the MOA so that the terms of the MOA may be completed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Stipulation VI (Amendments and Non-Compliance) of the MOA, the signatories have agreed that the MOA should be amended to extend its duration an additional five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, VAPSHCS will send a copy of this executed amendment to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP); and

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation VI (Amendments and Non-Compliance) of the MOA, VAPSHCS and the Washington SHPO agree to amend the MOA as follows:

Amend Stipulation IV so it reads as follows:

IV. Duration


This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) shall be null and void upon the date its terms are carried out, or in the alternative, the MOA shall be null and void if its terms are not carried out within fifteen (15) years from the date of its execution. Prior to such time, VAPSHCS may consult with other signatories to reconsider the terms of the MOA and amend it in accordance with the Amendment section below.

All remaining stipulations remain in full force and effect.

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
