

AMENDMENT #3 TO THE
PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT AMONG
THE UNITED STATES GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION,
THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION,
THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE,
THE NATIONAL CAPITAL PLANNING COMMISSION, AND,
THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY
REGARDING THE REDEVELOPMENT OF
ST. ELIZABETHS NATIONAL HISTORIC LANDMARK,
WASHINGTON, D.C.

WHEREAS, the Programmatic Agreement (PA) was executed on December 9, 2008, and amended a first time on June 14, 2018, to extend its duration to December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the second amendment to the PA, executed on December 21, 2021, extended the agreement's duration through June 30, 2022, and removed the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) as a Signatory; and

WHEREAS, the United States General Services Administration's (GSA) PA and St. Elizabeths Master Plan govern the Section 106 compliance for the redevelopment of St. Elizabeths National Historic Landmark for use as a high-security federal campus for the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Headquarters (Undertaking); and

WHEREAS, the redevelopment area remains defined as St. Elizabeths West Campus (hereafter referred to as the "Site"), a 176-acre campus which remains under the control and jurisdiction of GSA; and

WHEREAS, the Undertaking and its Area of Potential Effects (APE) remain unchanged; and

WHEREAS, the 2008 Master Plan, as amended and updated in 2020, is the active guiding document for the redevelopment of the Site; and

WHEREAS, the Parties anticipate that the Master Plan may be further updated and amended during the term of the PA only by mutual agreement of the Parties and in accordance with Stipulation III. B.1. "Modifications to Master Plan" of the PA; and

WHEREAS, GSA requests funds annually for the PA's stipulated mitigation measures and completes measures as funding becomes available.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation VII, the Signatories agree to amend the PA as follows:

XI. DURATION.

This Programmatic Agreement shall remain in effect until June 30, 2032, unless extended through an amendment per Stipulation VII or terminated as provided in Stipulation VIII.

All other terms remain unchanged.
