



SECTION 106 Essentials Training, Washington, DC

An in-depth look at historic preservation responsibilities under the National Historic Preservation Act

“The Section 106 Essentials Training” course will be held on Tuesday, June 16, 2026

Course Location: The course will take place in Room 337 on the third floor of the National Building Museum, 401 F Street NW, Washington DC 20001.

Schedule:

- Registration: 8:00 a.m.
- Training: 8:30 a.m. – approximately 4:30 p.m.
- Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a longer break for lunch.

Please note: The building’s main entrance opens at 8:30 a.m. If you arrive earlier, please use the loading dock entrance on the 4th Street side of the building. Attendees will be asked to show ID and sign in.

Transportation:

Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport is approximately 10 minutes (8 miles) from downtown Washington, DC. Transportation options include Metrorail, taxi, and shuttle services.

The venue is easily accessible via the Judiciary Square Metro Station (Red Line), using the F Street exit.

Public Transportation: Washington Metropolitan Area Transportation Authority (Metro) system is a very economical and accessible way to travel via rail and bus in the DC Area. The National Building Museum is across the street from the Judiciary Square metro stop. Take the F street exit. The red line serves this stop. Log onto www.wmata.com and use the Trip planner for your travel needs.

Note: Parking is not available at the National Building Museum.

Registration: Registration will be located in the conference room on Tuesday at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Meals:

Light morning refreshments and an afternoon snack will be provided. All other meals are on your own.

Attire:

Business casual attire is recommended. As room temperatures may vary, we suggest bringing a sweater or jacket.

Cancellations:

Cancellations made at least 14 days prior to the course will receive a full refund minus a 15% processing fee. No refunds will be issued for cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the course. Substitutions may be made at no cost up to three days prior. All cancellations must be submitted in writing.
