

**ACHP LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES REVISITED**  
**119th CONGRESS**

The following text shows the proposed updated legislative priorities discussed at the ACHP business meeting on June 4, 2026.

- Supporting preservation-friendly programs and funding
- Balancing regulatory/permitting reform with the interest of Section 106 stakeholders and protection of historic properties
- Reauthorizing and making permanent the Historic Preservation Fund
- Maintaining and enhancing tax incentives for historic preservation
- Encouraging development of technology to expand access to information about historic properties
- Supporting preservation and reuse of historic properties in community development, including for the creation of jobs and affordable housing
- Promoting consideration of historic properties in federal resilience planning related to flooding, wildfires, extreme weather events, and other disasters
- Fostering stewardship of historic properties on federal lands or under federal management.
