

AMENDMENT #1 TO
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
AMONG THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS, THE VETERANS

REGARDING THE REPLACEMENT COMMUNITY LIVING CENTER PROJECT AT
THE PERRY POINT VETERANS AFFAIRS MEDICAL CENTER, PERRYVILLE, MD

WHEREAS, the *Memorandum of Agreement among the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), the Veterans Affairs Maryland Health Care System, the Perry Point Veterans Affairs Medical Center (VAMC); the Maryland State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO); and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) regarding the Replacement Community Living Center Project at the Perry Point Veterans Affairs Medical Center, Perryville, MD (MOA)* was executed October 31, 2014 and pursuant to Stipulation VI. was stipulated to be in effect until October 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Perry Point VAMC has identified a need to extend the duration of the MOA to allow additional time to complete the undertaking and terms of the MOA; and

WHEREAS, the signatories have determined that it is appropriate to extend the duration of the MOA so that the remaining terms of the MOA may be completed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Stipulation XI. of the MOA, the signatories have agreed that the MOA should be amended to extend its duration an additional seven (7) years; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation XI. of the MOA, the Perry Point VAMC, SHPO, and ACHP agree to amend the MOA as follows:

Amend Stipulation VI. so it reads as follows:

VI. DURATION

This MOA will expire two (2) years after CLC construction is complete; or, fourteen (14) years from the date of the MOA's execution; or, upon written notification to the signatories of the completion of the project and the MOA's stipulations, whichever occurs first.

All remaining stipulations remain in full force and effect.


